



Call for Short-Term Scientific Mission (STSM) proposals

The COST Action [NexusLinguarum](#) (European network for Web-centred linguistic data science, CA18209) issues a new **call for Short-Term Scientific Mission (STSM) proposals to be carried out in the 4th Grant Period** (ending in October 2023).

Short Term Scientific Missions (STSMs) are visits to a host organization located in a **different country than the country of affiliation** by a **Researcher or Innovator** for the specific work to be carried out and for a determined period of time.

STSMs can be submitted on any topic directly related to the objectives of NexusLinguarum and its Working Groups. You can also have a look at suggested [active topics](#).

In accordance with COST rules, the amount granted for each STSM can be up to the level requested by the applicant or less; the exact amount will be determined by the Core Group on proposal of the Grant Evaluation Committee, based on the request of the applicant and taking into account the duration and location of the STSM.

For the 4th Grant Period, the funding of 8 STSMs with an **estimated amount of 2,500 EUR** each has been foreseen in the NexusLinguarum budget; depending on the justifications in the proposal (e.g. duration), this amount may vary.

Important dates (calls, applications, approval)

Application dates: Applications can be submitted at any time **until 15th of July 2023** (or until the budget is spent) but they will be evaluated at set collection dates.

Collection dates: **31st January, 31st March, 31st May, 31st July 2023**

Evaluation of applications: **15 days following the collection date***

Period for performing STSMs: as requested on the grant application and until **end of October 2023**

Deadline for reporting: 30 days after the completion of the STSM or 15 days after the end of the GP (end of 4th GP: October 30, 2023)

* Upon extraordinary conditions, the evaluation of an application may take place between the set collection dates, provided that the applicant adequately justifies this and the Grant Evaluation committee accepts this.
